

Preschool Reopen Plan

Your pastors are committed to making sure that we do everything we possibly can to provide a safe environment during these unique times. In addition to our normal stringent cleaning and safety guidelines, here are some of the additional Nest Ministry Safety Procedures we have put in place:

<u>Safety measures for The Nest Preschool classrooms:</u>

- Facilities/Housekeeping Ministry will continue to clean and disinfect each classroom and open
 Preschool Ministry spaces utilizing disinfectant-filled electrostatic sprayers and/or fogger machines.
- Hand sanitizers are located throughout the CFBC Nest Preschool hallway and inside the classrooms for leaders and preschoolers to sanitize hands as they enter the room.
- Solid surface will be wiped down.
- Snacks will not be offered at this time.
- Individual supplies for each child will be used as much as possible.
- Furniture has been condensed to assist with social distancing and disinfecting.
- Ministry check-in teams will be wearing masks and all other ministry leaders are highly encouraged to wear masks, but it is not required.
- Your child's teacher will not be socially distanced from him/her. Preschoolers will not be socially distanced from their classmates. Your child's class will become a group that will practice healthy hygiene

We are asking preschoolers to only bring in necessary items needed (diapers, change of clothes, cups) for the hour they are in the Nest Hall. We will be providing vinyl drawstring backpacks for needed items if you prefer not to use your diaper bag.

Wednesday Nights - Birth-PreK

On Wednesday, September 9, we will begin our reopening! For us to prepare with volunteers and classrooms, every child attending will need to pre-register for their class. Use this link to pre-register: Wednesday Night Class Registration

If you have a preschool or elementary-age child, please park in the back of the church. At this time check-in will be located inside the back doors by the kitchen. We ask that only 1 adult accompany children to the check-in area and any other family members enter the building by the back doors near the elevators.

6:10-6:30 pm Check-in:

- CFBC Preschool Ministry staff, volunteers, and children will undergo temperature checks before entering the secured area of the CFBC Preschool area.
- Each parent will receive preprinted pickup tags and the child's nametag.
- Preschoolers will walk to their rooms with a Preschool Ministry team member. If needed babies and toddlers may walk with the adult that is temperature checked to their door.

7:30 pm pick up:

- Pick up will be from the Lobby. You will enter our hall from the Lobby and then exit through the back kitchen door
- To help limit the number of people in the hallways, please only 1 adult accompanying child.
- There are markers on the floor outside of classroom doors to help parents safely social distance during pick up.
- Parents and children will then exit out the back doors/stairwell to the back parking lot.

Sunday Morning - Birth – 3-year-old as of September 1, 2020

On Sunday, September 13, we will have classes for Birth – 3-year-old (as of September 1, 2020.) For us to prepare with volunteers and classrooms, every child attending will need to pre-register for their class each week.

8:45 / 10:30 Check-in

- A check-in table will be in the main lobby by The Nest Hall door. We will have preprinted labels for your children.
- CFBC Preschool Ministry staff, volunteers, and children will undergo temperature checks before entering the secured area of the CFBC Preschool area.
- Each parent will receive preprinted pickup tags and the child's nametag.
- Preschoolers will walk to their rooms with a Preschool Ministry team member. If needed babies and toddlers may walk with the adult that is temperature checked to their door.
- Ministry check-in teams will be wearing masks and all other ministry leaders are highly encouraged to wear masks, but it is not required.

Pick up:

- After each service, one adult that has been temperature checked will be allowed to pick up their children from their classrooms.
- We ask that you walk to the room and back out of the hall with the awareness that we need to sanitize the halls as soon as possible.
