MORNING TIME

When you go into your child's room this month, say, "Good morning! God loves you THIS much (hold your arms out wide) and so do I!" (Wrap your arms around your child and give them a big hug.)



DRIVE TIME

As you drive, sing the following to the tune of "A Sailor Went to Sea": "God gives me what I need, need, need. God gives me what I need, need, need. God gives me what I need, need, need. Because He really loves me, me, me!"



CUDDLE TIME

Cuddle up with your child this month and pray, "Dear God, thank You for giving [child's name] to me. I love being his/her Mommy/Daddy. But as much as I love him/her, I know you love him/her even more! Your love for us is SO big! I pray we never forget it! You are the best, God, and we love You very much. In Jesus' name, amen."



BATH TIME

While bathing ur child, add a plastic container and something to scoop and pour the water. Tell ur child to scoop water into the container until they see it is half full. Next, tell them to fill it ALL the way to the top. Talk about the difference between half and ALL. Say the memory verse together. "Trust the Lord with ALL your heart," Proverbs 3:5. God wants us to trust him with ALL our heart.
