WORD: Battles—How To Fight

Passage: 2 Chronicles

Key Verse: 2 Chronicles 20:12

"We are powerless before the vast number that comes to fight against us. We do not know what to do but we look to you."

Commentary:

Are you in a battle? Did you just finish a battle? If not, you are headed toward one. Battles will always be with us for the enemy rests not. The enemy is big, and at times we feel just like Jehoshaphat: powerless, outnumbered, and not sure what to do. So then, how do we fight? ANSWER: We don't!!
